- 1. Выполнение домашнего задания, под которым подразумевается самостоятельная учебная деятельность аспирантов, нацеленная на закрепление материала, изученного на аудиторных занятиях, повторение пройденного и выполнение заданий необходимых для организации учебной работы под руководством преподавателя (предварительное чтение текстов, повторение лексики, выполнение грамматических упражнений, устный и письменный перевод, подготовка презентаций и т.д.). Контроль над выполнением осуществляется во время аудиторных занятий в результате фронтальных и выборочных опросов.
- 2. Развитие рецептивных видов речевой деятельности (чтение и аудирование) через чтение литературы на английском языке, просмотр видео-материалов, прослушивание аудио-материалов (по выбору преподавателя и аспиранта). Контроль над выполнением осуществляется за счет оценки подготовленного отчета о проделанной самостоятельной работе.
- 3. Самостоятельная работа над проектами. Проект «Presenting Academic Achievements to the World» осуществляется студентами индивидуально по разработанному преподавателем плану. Отчет о выполнении представляет собой презентацию результатов проделанной работы. Результатом проектной работы может быть участие аспиранта с докладом в англоязычной конференции или публикация статьи на английском языке.

Для осуществления текущего контроля и промежуточной аттестации используются тесты и тексты из банка контрольно-измерительных материалов, хранящихся на кафедре, которые периодические обновляются.

#### GLOBALIZATION

The word "globalization" stirs powerful emotions. Some see it as highly beneficial - a key to future world economic development, more opportunities and higher living standards across the world. Others see it as a malign force that increases inequality within and between nations, disempowers the weak, threatens employment and living standards, and increase poverty. Most people agree that the forces driving globalization - technological change, lower communication and transport costs, increased trade and financial integration among countries are powerful. But they need to be harnessed to make globalization work for the good of all. Clearly the gap between rich and poor is too wide and may even be widening. Today's central development challenges are to improve the lives and prospects for the nearly three billion people now living in poverty. Only if the economies in which they live grow faster, can the lives of this enormous group of people be improved. Globalization can contribute to this faster growth. But it also increases the need for stronger policies at the national level. And it means that the international community must adapt the way in which it assists poor countries. Globalization is no longer an abstraction but a stark reality that virtually all firms, large and a small, face. Firms that want to survive in the 21st century must confront this all encompassing force that pervades every aspect of business. In a wide range of industries from automobiles to food and clothing, firms face the pressures of global competition at homes as well as in

international markets is no longer an option. All firms, regardless of their size, have to craft strategies in the broader context of world markets to anticipate, respond and adapt to the changing configuration of these markets.

Technology is rapidly altering the nature of competition and strategy in many industries. Then global proliferation of relatively inexpensive computing power and global linkages of computer networks through telecommunications have resulted in an information-rich, computation-rich and communication-rich organizational environment. Telecommunications and computer networks are changing the way in which managers work and interact, providing links between country-centered organizations, and permitting technology to be rapidly shared and learning transferred throughout the organization.

As a result, speed of technological diffusion and change is rapidly increasing. At the same time, the growing technological orientation of many industries and use of computers and telecommunications technology have created greater knowledge intensity and dependency.

Competition is also intensifying, as globalization changes the boundaries of competition and new sources of competition emerge. The basis for competition is also changing, as new players are able to enter the market with an ease unknown even ten years ago.

Information technology has dramatically transformed the costs of doing business and enabled firms to bypass stages in the value chain, for example, going directly to customers, or outsourcing functions and operations. Such factors have changed the nature of the value chain in many industries, enabling new and non-traditional competitors to enter the market rapidly and compete effectively.
